## Clothing

- □ 6-8 Pairs of underwear
- □ 6 Pairs of Socks
- □ 1-2 Pairs of pajamas
- □ 1 Rain coat
- □ 1 Pair of closed-toe athletic shoes
- □ 1 Pair of flip flops
- □ 1 Pair of shoes to wear in the river/around Camp
